



### **DIRECTIONS: SKIRT**

1. Iron right sides together with fusible webbing. (2 seams, fit to size)
2. Attach a safety pin to the end of the silk cording and pin to skirt where waist band will be.
3. Turn the top edge of the bandanna in half for waist. Iron together using fusible webbing making sure not to lose the other end of the silk cording. Gather the waist when ironing so as not to lose the end of the cord.
4. Unpin the cording and gather the skirt, tying the ends together in a bow.
5. Using the fabric glue attach the beading along the bottom of the skirt on the right side. (See Photo)

### **MATERIALS:**

Three (3) bandannas  
T-shirt (your child's size) - (1)  
Canvas tote - 14" x 14" - (1)  
One (1) yard of silk cording  
Iron and ironing surface  
Fusible webbing  
Fabric glue  
Tape

Stiffening liquid  
Beaded trim - (3) packages  
Small tapered scissors  
Medium safety pin  
Hair dryer  
Cardboard - (1) piece, same size as T-shirt  
Wax paper - to cover cardboard

### **DIRECTIONS: SHIRT**

1. Cut image out of the 2nd bandanna.
2. Tape wax paper to cardboard.
3. Place covered cardboard inside the shirt. (This prevents the shirt from sticking together)
4. Glue cut out of image to shirt.
5. Glue beaded trim around collar of shirt.

### **DIRECTIONS: TOTE**

1. Cut Strawberry Shortcake™ out of the 3rd bandanna.
2. Glue to the front of tote. (See Photo)
3. Glue beaded trim around the top seam of the tote.
